

Chapter 13 – Sign Up with Paypal

You need to sign up with paypal to accept credit card payments on your web shop.

1. Open your web browser (eg Internet Explorer) and go to <https://www.paypal.com>
2. Click the **Sign up** button and follow the instructions for a **Premier** account.
3. When asked, apply for **Website Payments Standard**.
4. When your account has been confirmed by paypal
5. Start at the OS Commerce Administration page <http://bxb.biz/your 6 digit webshop code/admin>

7) Set Preparing Order Status is Preparing [PayPal IPN] → Set Preparing Order Status

10) Transaction Type is Aggregate → Transaction Type
Send individual items to PayPal or aggregate all as one total item?

11) Move tax to total amount is False → Move tax to total amount
Do you want to move the tax to the total amount? If true PayPal will always show the total amount including tax. (needs Aggregate instead of Per Item to function)

12) Leave Page Style blank → Page Style
The page style to use for the transaction procedure (defined at your PayPal Profile page)

13) If you have a different email address enter it at Debug E-Mail Address, if not, enter your normal email address → Debug E-Mail Address
All parameters of an Invalid IPN notification will be sent to this email address if one is entered.

14) Leave cURL Proxy server blank → cURL Proxy server
If curl transactions need to go through a proxy, type the address here starting with http://. Otherwise, leave it blank. The current GoDaddy proxy address is http://proxy.shr.secureserver.net:3128

15) Enable Encrypted Web Payments is False → Enable Encrypted Web Payments

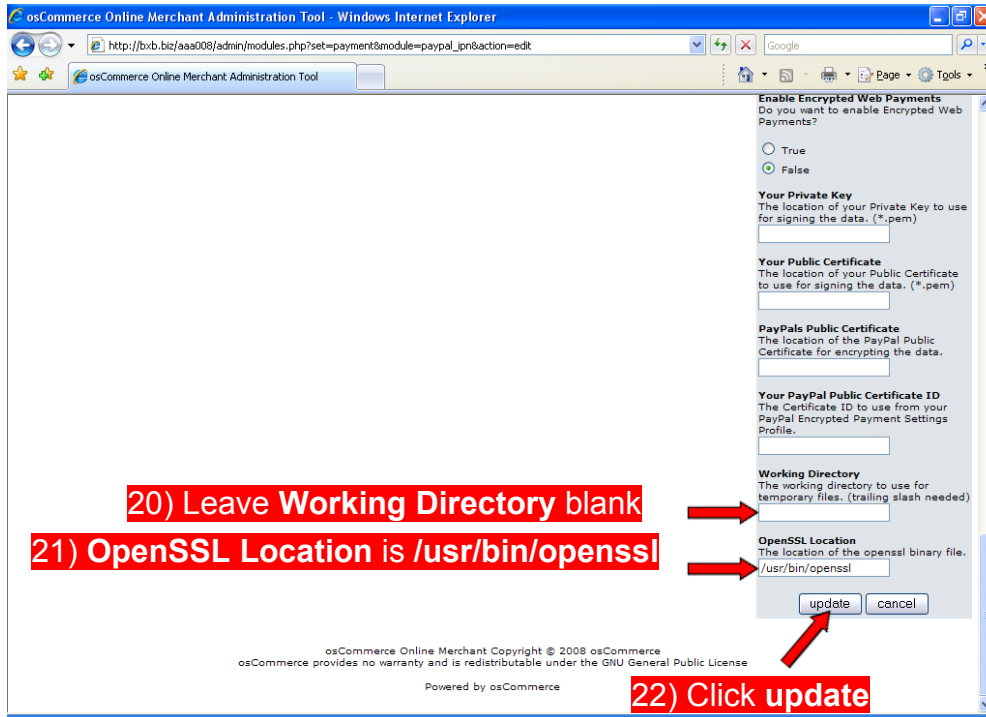
16) Leave Your Private Key blank → Your Private Key
The location of your Private Key to use for signing the data. (*.pem)

17) Leave Your Public Certificate blank → Your Public Certificate
The location of your Public Certificate to use for signing the data. (*.pem)

18) Leave PayPals Public Certificate blank → PayPals Public Certificate
The location of the PayPal Public Certificate for encrypting the data.

19) Leave Your PayPal Public Certificate ID blank → Your PayPal Public Certificate ID
The Certificate ID to use from your PayPal Encrypted Payment Settings Profile.

Working Directory
The working directory to use for temporary files. (trailing slash needed)
